We are committed to providing a safe, welcoming environment for all members, guests and staff. The following membership code reflects our values of caring, honesty, respect and responsibility. We reserve the right to revoke membership privileges (without refund) at any time for violation of policies or behavior unbecoming to our mission and/or character values.

Please Scan For Safety: For security purposes, we ask that all members scan their key Y tag for access at each visit to the facility. Loaned or expired key tags will be collected by Y staff. Please report lost or stolen key tags so that we may issue replacements.

Please Use Storage: Please store all personal belongings in lockers or storages spaces. For the safety of our members and guests, bags and other personal belongings are not permitted in areas other than those referenced above. We encourage visitors to lock their personal belongings as we are not responsible for items lost or stolen items. Lockers are available as a member benefit for day usage. Lockers are also available for rental. Please place wet shoes below locker areas.

Health First: To encourage healthy living, the YMCA is a smoke-free environment. Smoking and vaping is not allowed on YMCA property, including the entryway and parking lots.

We Support Your Needs: Seeing Eye Dogs and Service Dogs are permitted in the building. Please see the Y welcome center and/or Wellness Director for details.

Your Safety First: We are a place of safe recreation, thus, illegal drugs, firearms or weapons of any kind are banned from the facility. Using or possessing alcohol (unless express permission is granted for special events) is prohibited.

Please Respect One Another: Please demonstrate respect for the equipment, building and each other. Harassment or intimidation verbally or physically, for example engaging with another person in an angry, aggressive or threatening manner, or other generally offensive behaviors with another person is prohibited. This includes but is not limited to angry or vulgar language/shouting, sexually-explicit conversation/contact or the like.

Environmentally Comfortable: Please wear attire that is appropriate for a family environment. If you have any questions regarding appropriate attire, please ask a staff member for clarification. Please note our two-shoe policy is also in effect during winter months.

We Care About You: For the safety and security of our members and guests, all video/photo devices (including mobile phones and tablets) may not be used in YMCA locker rooms or restrooms. Loud phone conversations should take place outside the facility. If you are in the fitness center, please take phone calls away from the fitness center and not while using the equipment.

Locker Room Ages: Children five and younger, or not yet in first grade may use opposite-gender locker rooms. Children six and older can use the same-gender locker rooms. For your comfortability, we recommend children ages 6-10 be accompanied by a parent of the same gender. Private changing stalls are also available.

Fitness Center: For health and safety, we ask that all members clean all fitness machines after use. Wipes, paper towels, and disinfectant sprays are located throughout the Fitness Center for your convenience. Please refrain from using cell phones in the fitness center or sitting idle on machines. During peak times cardio usage should be limited to 30 minutes at a time.

Food and Beverage: Our Y is a great meeting place for everyone, however, we ask that all food be eaten in the Fireplace area. The Community Center and Odyssey Center can only be used with prior approval. There is no food allowed in the Gymnasium, Fitness Center or studios.
