THE FINAL STEEL BEAM OF THE EXETER AREA YMCA IS READY FOR YOUR SIGNATURE Community members are invited to sign the final beam and watch it be put into place!

January 30, 2015 (Exeter, NH) – If you’ve driven past the Exeter facility lately, you know that the steel framing is coming together quickly. The last beam is scheduled to top the project next week!

On Thursday, February 5, community members are invited to sign the final beam of the structure and see it hoisted into place and complete the frame of the building.

WHERE: 56 Linden Street, Exeter, NH 03833
Parking is available in the YMCA parking lot. Please enter through the east gate of the construction site.

NOTES: This is a free outdoor event. The ground is frozen and may be uneven. Individuals with mobility issues are welcome to sign the beam, but should call 603 642 3361 for parking arrangements.
